I am to inform that the Meeting of the Board of Studies in Siddha Course was held on 10.11.2017 and discussed various academic matters. The decisions of the Board of Studies in Siddha was approved in the 54<sup>th</sup> meeting of the Standing Academic Board, held on 07.12.2017 and recorded in Resolution No:40 in the 258<sup>th</sup> Meeting of the Governing Council held on 18.12.2017 which are detailed below: POINT No.1

TO DISCUSS AND RECOMMEND THE REVAMPED SYLLABUS FRAMED BY THE EXPERT COMMITTEE FOR THE SUBJECTS OF SIDDHA UG/PG DEGREE COURSES UNDER AYUSH.

It was resolved to approve the revamped syllabus for the subjects of Siddha UG degree course (AYUSH). This will be implemented from the academic year 2017-18 admission onwards.

The publication of the syllabus for PG course by the Central Council of Indian Medicine, New Delhi, is awaited.

POINT No.2

TO DISCUSS AND DECIDE FOR IMPLEMENTING THE MD SIDDHA REGULATIONS, WHICH WAS FORWARDED BY CENTRAL COUNCIL OF INDIAN MEDICINE, NEW DELHI.

It was resolved to implement the IMCC PG Siddha Education Regulations 2016, vide ref. No.11011/-1/2016-dated 10.10.2017 and its seat matrix as follows:-

The PG Specialities in Siddha viz., Sirappu Maruthuvam had been discontinued and the newly introduced PG specialities viz., Pura Maruthuvam, Varma Maruthuvam,Siddhar Yoga Maruthuvam will function under the Department of Varmam, Pura maruthuvam & Sirappu Maruthuvam, the number of PG seats allocated to Sirappu maruthuvam can be divided among the said new specialities, and the concerned colleges may be allowed to start these new specialities in place of Sirappu maruthuvam subject to the fulfillment of provisions prescribed in regulation 16 & 17 of IMCC PG Siddha Education regulations 2016, but not exceeding the number of seats already permitted last year by Government of India in the speciality of Sirappu Maruthuvam of each college.

I am to request that the decision of the Standing Academic Board as mentioned above may be communicated to all the Professors and Heads of Departments for information and further follow up action in the regard. I am also to request that a copy of this letter may be displayed on the Notice Board of the College / Hostel for information of the students concerned.
