### **Proposal Review Process**

Project Screening Committee members will screen the proposals and provide their comments and score on following criteria:

• Skill and capacity of research team (PI, Co-PI):	20
• Publications* since 01-Jan-2020 including IF	20
• Impact of publications (public health policy/clinical protocol/patent)	20
• Concept note of proposed research	40
Total	100

**The concept proposals will be shortlisted based on scores. If the project is shortlisted, The PI will then be requested to submit a detailed proposal. The chosen individual will be required to present a detailed proposal in person at the University, before a committee of experts. After the presentation, the proposal will undergo a review and finalized by the project review committee.**
