	A Clinical department or its Unit Training candidates for broad or super Specialities shall have a minimum of three full time faculty members belonging to the concerned disciplines. Faculty component in the first unit shall include one Professor and other will be Associate Professor/ Reader, Assistant Professor / Lecturer possessing, Recognized requisite the qualification and experience prescribed by the Medical Council of India.				
	<p><b><u>Note:-</u></b></p> <p>(i) Of these faculty members only those who possess a total of eight years teaching experience, out of which at least five years teaching experience as Assistant Professor/ Lecturer gained after obtaining postgraduate Degree, shall be recognized as Postgraduate teachers.</p> <p>(ii) In each department training candidates for Super Specialities there shall be a minimum of three faculty members with requisite post graduate qualification and experience – one professor,/Reader/and one Assistant Professor/ Professor/Lecturer with at least two of them holding the degrees of D.M./M.Ch. in the concerned discipline. Of these faculty members only those who possess eight years teaching experience out of which at least five years teaching experience as Asst. Professor/ Lecturer gained after obtaining the Super Speciality degree shall be Recognized as postgraduate teachers.</p>				

<p>(iii) The qualification prescribe in the recommendations of the Medical Council of India should be adhered to strictly, for appointment of teachers in Medical Colleges and attached Hospital.</p>			
<p>(iv)(a) The ratio of recognized postgraduate teacher and number of students to be admitted for the degree and diploma courses, shall be 1: 2 each for degree and diploma courses, in each unit per year, to the extent that in no circumstances more than 2 students for degree and one for diploma shall be registered in a unit in one academic year.</p>			
<p>b) In case the instituion is having only Postgraduate Diploma courses in any subject then it shall have a Unit of 30 beds with 3 full time teachers. The ratio of number of studdents and recognized Postgraduate teacher shall be 1:2 and in no circumastances more than three students can be admitted in a Unit per year.</p>			
<p>(c) The requirement of units and beds shall not apply in the case of post-graduate degree and diploma courses in basic and para-clinical departments. The ratio of recognised postgraduate teacher to students shall, however, Be maintained at 1: 2 both at degree as well as diploma level.</p>			
<p>(d) The number of students, to be admitted in case of postgraduate degree (super-speciality) courses shall be one student per year per recognised postgraduate teacher in a department having a minimum of three faculty members (one Professor, one Associate Prof./ Reader and one Assistant Professor/Lecturer) and 20 beds. If the Number of postgraduate teachers in the unit is more than one then the number of students may be increased proportionately but not more than two in a unit per year in any circumstances. For this purpose one student should associate with one postgraduate teacher.</p>			

	<p>In addition to the Faculty staff, the strength of Residents/Registrar/Tutors Registrar/Tutors/Demonstrators as well as Technical and other paramedical staff shall be as per the staff strength prescribed for 50 or 100 or 150 students in the “Minimum Requirements for 50/100/150 MBBS Admissions Regulations”.</p> <p><b>Note:</b> Particulars regarding teaching and non-teaching staff with their qualifications and experience attached with concerned Departments shall be enclosed.</p>
