

GUIDELINES/REGULATIONS FOR NON-MEDICAL FACULTIES TO DO Ph.D. RESEARCH PROGRAMME IN THIS UNIVERSITY.

1. The candidates who aspire to register for Ph.D can register as “Full Time or Part Time” as per the existing Regulations.

2. The candidates who seek registration for Ph.D must have a minimum work experience of two years after qualifying the PG Degree in any affiliated institutions of this university.

3. The Guide should be in the list of Recognized Guides of the Tamilnadu Dr. MGR Medical University and the Co-Guide can be from any recognized university within India or overseas however he must register as a Co-Guide at the Tamilnadu Dr. MGR Medical University.

4. The candidates are permitted to do their Ph.D only in their Post Graduate Degree subject.

5. The members suggested that the candidates who wish to register for a Ph.D Degree should have obtained a minimum of 55% as aggregate in their Post Graduate Degree.

6. The candidates who register for Ph.D must do their research work in the department recognized/institutions recognized by this university.

7. The members suggested that the Ph.D Degree awarded to Non-Medical M.Sc candidates be given as “Ph.D in Allied Health Sciences (Non-Medical subject).

Mandatory requisites for Ph.D Registration

- Undergraduate qualification (DENTAL, AYUSH, NURSING, PHARMACY, BPT, BOT) imparted by any medical/health sciences universities recognized by the respective Central Councils with Post Graduate qualification in Basic Sciences, Basic Medical Sciences , Medical/Surgical Specialties / Super Specialties.

- For MBBS graduates the existing Ph.D regulations can be followed.

This will be implemented with effect from PhD registration Session July 2015 onwards.
