In exercise of the powers conferred by section 42 of the Tamil Nadu Dr.M.G.R. Medical University, Chennai, Act, 1987 (Tamil Nadu Act 37 of 1987), the Governing Council of the Tamil Nadu Dr.M.G.R. Medical University, Chennai hereby repeals the Existing Medical College Statutes and makes the following Statutes.

STATUTES

1. (i) These statutes may be called the Tamil Nadu Dr.M.G.R. Medical University (Affiliation of Medical Colleges) Statutes.
(ii) They shall come into force from the date of assent of the Chancellor.
2. The words and phrases used in these statutes shall, unless expressly explained otherwise, have the same meaning as they have with reference to the Tamil Nadu Dr. M.G.R. Medical University, Chennai, Act, 1987 (Tamil Nadu Act 37 of 1987) herein after called “the Act”.
3. It shall be necessary for the proposed Medical colleges seeking Affiliation to the Tamil Nadu Dr. M.G.R. Medical University, Chennai for starting first year M.B.B.S. Degree course to apply to the University for issue of “Letter of Consent of Affiliation” to enable them to obtain the permission of the Central Government in accordance with the Section 10A of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956 and the Regulations and Schemes notified thereunder from time to time.
4. The application for issue of “Letter of Consent of Affiliation” from the Tamil Nadu Dr. M.G.R. Medical University, Chennai shall be in writing and in Form I annexed with these statutes addressed to the Registrar of the Tamil Nadu Dr. M.G.R. Medical University, Chennai and shall be submitted to the

Registrar between 1st July and 31st October along with a processing fee of Rs.3,00,000/- (Rupees three lakhs only) or such amount as may be prescribed by the Governing Council from time to time.

5. (i) Only Educational Trust / Societies / Organisation as defined in the Medical Council of India Regulations, which satisfy the conditions stipulated hereunder in statutes 6 and 7 shall be eligible to apply for "Letter of Consent of Affiliation" for applying to the Central Government for their permission to establish a new Medical College / increase in intake capacity.

(ii) Applications from individuals for "Letter of Consent of Affiliation" shall not be entertained.

6. (A) CONDITIONS TO BE SATISFIED BY THE TRUSTS / SOCIETIES / ORGANISATION FOR APPLYING FOR LETTER OF CONSENT OF AFFILIATION

(i) The Trusts / Societies / Organisation shall produce a copy of the "Essentiality Certificate" obtained from the State Government and also produce a copy of Trust Deed.

(ii) LAND REQUIREMENTS:-

(a) The Trusts / Societies / Organisation shall own and possess a suitable single plot of land as per medical Council of India norms or as may be prescribed by the Medical Council of India from time to time for varied intake capacity of 50/100/150/200/250. (As per Annexure-I)

(b) The Trust shall have clear marketable title to the land without any encumbrance and shall produce copies of the registered title deed, encumbrance certificate, legal opinion of the Government Pleader, Sworn Affidavit and such other documents as required by the University from time to time.

(c) The proposed Medical College or the Medical institution and the attached hospital shall be housed in a unitary campus.

(iii) HOSPITAL:-

(a) The Trust shall own and possess a hospital of atleast one year functional standing with the minimum bed strength prescribed by Medical Council of India from time to time for varied intake capacity of 50/100/150/200/250 and with 80 % of average bed occupancy as per Annexure-I.

(b) The hospital shall have out-patient sections and in-patient sections such as Medicine, Surgery, Paediatrics, Obstetrics and Gynaecology, Orthopaedics, Oto-rhino-Laryngology, Ophthalmology with facilities like Radiology, Clinical Laboratories, Blood Bank and operation theatres etc., as prescribed by the Medical Council of India from time to time.

(c) There must be out patient turnover of minimum 8 cases per student per day.

(d) The hospital must have its own administrative staff.

(e) Should have a master plan for the future teaching hospital with a bed strength with all other required facilities including specialities, as may be prescribed by the Medical Council of India from time to time as per Annexure-II for varied intake capacity of 50/100/150/200/250.

(iv) READY BUILT AREA:-

The proposed Medical College shall have all the Departments as prescribed by the Medical Council of India from time to time with the requisite floor area for varied intake capacity of 50/100/150/200/250. The required floor space for 50/100/150 intake capacity are as given in Annexure-II. For 200/250 intake capacity, the floor area as prescribed by Medical Council of India shall be followed from time to time.

NOTE: The proposed Medical College should have commenced the construction of building of the above said areas to house the college and the building should have reached atleast the roof level of Top floor of its construction at the time of first inspection by the University for issue of "Letter of Consent of Affiliation".

(v) HOSTEL:

The proposed college shall have separate hostel for boys and girls to accommodate 75 % of the intake as prescribed by the Medical Council of India from time to time.

NOTE: The construction of the hostel building should have commenced and reached atleast the roof level of Top floor of its construction at the time of first inspection by the University for issue of "Letter of Consent of Affiliation".

(vi) SECURITY DEPOSIT:

The Trust shall have the capacity to pay Rs.1,00,00,000/- (Rupees one crore only) as Security Deposit in three phases as under:-

(a) Rs.20,00,000/- (Rupees twenty lakhs only) at the time of Affiliation of first year M.B.B.S. Degree course.

(b) Rs.40,00,000/- (Rupees forty lakhs only) at the time of Affiliation of second batch of M.B.B.S. Degree course.

(c) Rs.40,00,000/- (Rupees forty lakhs only) at the time of Affiliation of third batch of M.B.B.S. Degree course.

(vii) OTHER FACILITIES:

The proposed college shall have facilities for:-

(a) Adequate water supply and drainage,

(b) Electricity supply and

(c) Adequate transport facilities and free access to the proposed college premises.

(B) CONDITIONS TO BE SATISFIED BY THE COLLEGE FOR ISSUE OF LETTER OF CONSENT OF AFFILIATION FOR INCREASE/VARIATION IN INTAKE (EXAMPLE: 100-150)

(1) The college shall produce a copy of the Essentiality Certificate obtained from the State Government.

(2) Proportionate increase in the teaching faculty and other staff.

(3) Proportionate increase in infrastructural facilities including Library books, Journals and Floor areas.

(4) No medical college shall apply to the University for increase in seats until the first batch of students has successfully completed the course and left the college and the M.B.B.S. Degree so obtained is recognized by the Medical Council of India.

7. The applicant Trust / Society / Organisation shall also payment of Rs.50,000/- (Rupees fifty thousand only) or such amount as may be fixed by the Governing Council from time to time towards

inspection fee and a payment of Rs.,3,00,000/- (Rupees three lakhs only) or such amount as may be fixed by the Governing Council from time to time towards processing fee for issue of “Letter of Consent of Affiliation” payable to the University for deputing its inspection commission to the proposed college.

8. On receipt of the application along with Inspection Proforma duly filled in from the applicant Trust, the University shall appoint and depute its inspection commission to verify the infrastructural facilities provided in the proposed college and to submit a report to the University to consider the issue of “Letter of Consent of Affiliation”.

9. The University after detailed examination of the report of the Inspection Commission, if fully satisfied on the fulfillment of the required infrastructural facilities shall issue “Letter of Consent of Affiliation” in Form II annexed with these statutes to the applicant Trust to enable it to apply to the Central Government for prior permission to establish a new Medical college / increase of intake.

10. The issue of Letter of Consent of Affiliation alone shall not confer any right on the applicant Trust / Society / Organisation to start the M.B.B.S. degree course.

11. The grant of Provisional Affiliation for starting the I year M.B.B.S. degree course of study, after the Government of India granted their prior permission to the Trust / Society / Organisation for starting the proposed Medical College / increase of intake, shall be issued by the University after verification of the appointment of required teaching faculties, provision of all required infrastructure and other facilities in full for starting the first year of course through an Inspection Commission. The applicant Trust / Society / Organisation after obtaining the prior permission of the Central Government shall make an application to this University for Provisional Affiliation in Form III.

12. The applicant Trust / Society / Organisation shall, before applying for Affiliation for the first M.B.B.S. degree course of study, fulfill the following conditions, namely:-

(a) The hospital run by the Trust / Society / Organisation shall be well organized with the bed strength as prescribed by Medical council of India from time to time for varied intake capacity of 50/100/150/200/250 and with separate out patients sections and with such other facilities:

(i) As prescribed by the Medical Council of India from time to time for medicine with separate beds for Paediatrics, Psychiatry, Dermatology, Venereology, Tuberculosis and Chest diseases.

(ii) As prescribed by the Medical Council of India from time to time for General Surgery with separate beds for Paediatric Surgery, Orthopaedics, Ophthalmology, E.N.T.

(iii) As prescribed by the Medical Council of India from time to time of Midwifery with sections of Obstetrics and Gynaecology and Antenatal, Neonatal and Family Planning Wings.

(iv) Mortuary, with cold storage facilities for not less than 25 bodies, rooms for staff, postmortem tables, equipments for postmortems with gallery arrangement for students.

(v) Well organized hospital kitchen with a capacity to cater to 800 beds in the near future.

(b) There shall be separate college building sufficient to accommodate the pre-clinical departments as prescribed by the Medical Council of India from time to time for all the Departments required for a Medical College with varied intake capacity of 50/100/150/200/250 as per Annexure-II.

13. The applicant Trust / Society / Organisation after fulfilling the conditions stipulated in the above statute, shall intimate the fact to the University in writing along with Inspection Proforma duly filled in and a sum of Rs.50,000/- (Rupees fifty thousand only) or such amount as may be prescribed by the Governing Council from time to time towards the inspection fee payable to the University and shall request the University to depute its inspection commission. On receipt of the above intimation the University shall send its inspection commission to inspect the facilities available at the proposed medical college and to submit report to the University as to the satisfactory fulfillment of the conditions required to be fulfilled with a copy of the Inspection Proforma submitted by the applicant for verification. The inspection commission shall also report and lacunae, if any, in the fulfillment of any of the conditions required to be fulfilled and also advise as to the capability of the Trust / Society / Organisation to rectify the lacunae, within a period of two months. In case there are lacunae in the fulfillment of the conditions, the University may conduct such re-inspection on payment of a sum of Rs.50,000/- (Rupees fifty

thousand only) or such amount as may be prescribed by the Governing Council from time to time towards the re-inspection fee and shall receive a final report from the inspection commission.

14. After a detailed examination of the final report of the inspection commission and if the University is fully satisfied as to the fulfillment of the conditions for the Affiliation for the first M.B.B.S. degree course of study, the University shall direct the applicant Trust / Society / *Organisation* to create a sum of Rs.20,00,000/- (Rupees twenty lakhs only) towards the 1st Instalment of security deposit invested in a fixed deposit in a Nationalised Bank or Government undertaking / Corporation which accepts fixed deposits jointly in the names of the Registrar, the Tamil Nadu Dr.M.G.R. Medical University, Chennai and the Trust / Society / *Organisation*. The Fixed Deposit receipt shall be kept in the custody of the Registrar. The interest accrued therein shall be utilised towards maintenance of the college.

15. On furnishing Rs.20,00,000/- (Rupees twenty lakhs only) towards the security deposit by the applicant Trust / Society / *Organisation* and on receipt of the intimation from the applicant Trust / Society / *Organisation*, that all the staff members appointed are in a positions to start the teaching course, the University shall grant Provisional Affiliation for the first M.B.B.S. course of study, after collecting a sum of Rs.40,00,000/- (Rupees forty lakhs only) or such amount as may be prescribed by the Governing Council from time to time towards the fee for the Provisional Affiliation for the First M.B.B.S. Degree course of study. It shall be competent for the University to withdraw the Provisional Affiliation granted herein by giving 3 months notice stating the reasons therefor to the management of the proposed college. The interest accrued on the fixed deposit shall be spent on the maintenance of the proposed medical college and the applicant shall submit an Utilisation Certificate in this regard in Form No.V annexed with this Statute at the end of every academic year.

16. The management of the proposed medical college shall show evidence of an annual income of not less than Rs.15,00,00,000/- (Rupees fifteen crores only) or such amount as may be prescribed by the Governing Council from time to time to facilitate the proper running of the medical college. This is

only a portion of the liability which the college is likely to incur every year towards payment of salaries to the teaching staff and the maintenance of the hospital.

17 (1) The Provisional Affiliation granted by the University shall be only for the first year M.B.B.S. course of study. There upon the college shall be permitted to admit students in such number in the First Year M.B.B.S. course of study.

(2) The Medical College shall furnish a budget for each year of study and a separate development budget which will cover the expenses for the fulfillment of the requirements prescribed for the second batch of M.B.B.S. course of study.

(3) Every College shall have a duly constituted Governing body with representatives of the teaching staff, to advise the Principal in the internal affairs of the College. A record of proceedings of the said governing body of the college shall be maintained by the Principal. Any change in the Governing Body of the College shall be reported to the University immediately.

(4) The Governing body of the College shall meet at least once in every three months to consider the budget estimates and such other matters as may arise in its working it shall meet in May-June each year to consider the Annual Report, the audited statement of accounts, changes in the staff, subjects or courses in which fresh Affiliation or approval is to be sought in the following year. A copy of the notice of meeting shall be sent to the Registrar, at least, 15 clear days before the date of the meeting. A copy of the minutes of the meeting shall also be sent to the Registrar within 15 days of the meeting.

(5) The Medical College seeking Affiliation shall follow the course contents and regulations of the Medical Council of India as modified from time to time. The college shall also follow the modifications in the course contents approved by the Standing Academic Board of the University from time to time.

18. By the time only 6 months period is left for the first M.B.B.S. students to take up the first M.B.B.S. examination, the management of the medical college shall apply to the University for Affiliation of the second batch of M.B.B.S. Course. Before applying so, the following facilities and departments with the staff members stipulated herein have to be provided by the management of the medical

college. The management of the medical college shall be provided with the following details as prescribed by the Medical Council of India from time to time vide Annexure-II.

(i) Development of the teaching hospitals.

(ii) Buildings, space to accommodate Pharmacology, Pathology, Microbiology, Forensic Medicine, Community Medicine, Medicine, Surgery and Obstetrics and Gynaecology departments.

(iii) List of equipments required in each department.

(iv) List of staff to be appointed.

The hospital shall have the bed strength as prescribed by Medical Council of India from to time as per Annexure-II with more units of Medicine, Surgery, Obstetrics and Gynaecology.

The requirements and conditions shall be fulfilled in the out patient block in addition to the Central casualty services as prescribed by the Medical Council of India from time to time.

19. On receipt of the application of Affiliation along with Inspection Proforma duly filled in for the second batch of M.B.B.S. course from the management of the medical college, the University shall send its inspection commission atleast 3 months before the date of commencement of the first year M.B.B.S. Examination. A sum of Rs.50,000/- (Rupees fifty thousand only) or such amount as may be fixed by the Governing Council from time to time, payable to the Tamil Nadu Dr.M.G.R. Medical University, Chennai shall be enclosed along with application towards the inspection fee.

20. The Inspection Commission sent by the University shall inspect the facilities made available by the management of the college duly verifying the filled-in Inspection Proforma and report to the University as to whether all the facilities required to be provided by the college are provided. The inspection commission shall also point out in its report the lacunae if any in the fulfillment of the conditions required to be fulfilled and also advice as to the capability of the college to rectify the lacunae within a period of two months. In case there are lacunae in the fulfillment of the conditions the University may conduct such re-inspection on payment of a sum Rs.50,000/- (Rupees fifty thousand only) or such

amount as may be fixed by the Governing Council from time to time towards the re-inspection fee and shall receive a final report from the Inspection Commission.

21. After a detailed examination of the final report of the inspection commission, if the University is fully satisfied as to the fulfillment of the conditions for the Affiliation for the second batch of M.B.B.S. degree course of study, the University shall direct the management of the college to remit a sum of Rs.40,00,000/- (Rupees forty lakhs only) towards the IInd instalment security deposit payable by the Trust / Society / Organisation. The security deposit shall be invested in a fixed deposit in a Nationalised Bank or Government Undertaking / Corporation which accepts fixed deposits jointly in the name of the Registrar, the Tamil Nadu Dr.M.G.R. Medical University and the Trust / Society / Organisation. The fixed deposit receipt shall be kept in the custody of the Registrar.

22. On furnishing Rs.40,00,000/- (Rupees forty lakhs only) towards the IInd instalment security deposit made by the applicant college and on production of renewal permission of the Government of India/Medical Council of India and on receipt of the intimation from the applicant college that all the staff members appointed in pursuance of the above statute are in a position to start the teaching course the University shall, after collecting prescribed fee of Rs.6,00,000/- for 50/100 admissions and Rs.9,00,000/- for 150 admissions respectively *or such amount as may be fixed by the Governing Council from time to time* from the Trust / Society / Organisation towards the Continuance of Provisional Affiliation fee shall grant Continuance of Provisional Affiliation for the second batch of M.B.B.S course of study. It shall be competent for the University to withdraw the Provisional Affiliation granted herein by giving 3 months notice stating the reasons therefor to the management of the college.

23. (1) The Continuance of Provisional Affiliation granted above by the University shall be only for the second batch of M.B.B.S. course of study. Thereupon the University shall permit the College admit the students in the second batch of M.B.B.S. degree course of study.

(2) The Medical College shall furnish a budget for each year of study and separate development budget which will cover the expenses for the fulfillment of the requirement prescribed for the fifth batch including CRR of M.B.B.S. course of study.

24. GRANT OF THIRD AND FOURTH BATCH OF M.B.B.S. CONTINUANCE OF PROVISIONAL AFFILIATION:-

The Management of the Medical college shall apply to this University after complying with the requisite facilities, as prescribed by the Medical Council of India from time to time for grant of Continuance of Provisional Affiliation for third and fourth batch of M.B.B.S. degree course as detailed in the annexure to the statement and following the said procedure prescribed for second batch of M.B.B.S. degree course stated above on remitting the requisite fee and Security Deposit at the same rate.

25. On receipt of the application along with Inspection Proforma duly filled in for the fifth batch including CRR I of M.B.B.S. course from the management of the Medical College the University shall send its inspection commission atleast 3 months before the commencement of the next batch of M.B.B.S. examination. The application for Continuance of Provisional Affiliation shall be accompanied with a sum of Rs.50,000/- (Rupees fifty thousand only) or such amount as may be prescribed by the Governing Council from time to time, shall be paid by the management of the medical college, payable to the Tamil Nadu Dr.M.G.R. Medical University, Chennai towards inspection fee.

26. Compulsory Rotatory Resident Internship (C.R.R.I.) Training:- By the time only 6 months period is left for the fifth batch of M.B.B.S. Students to take up the fifth batch of M.B.B.S. Examination, the management of the Medical college shall apply to the University for Affiliation of Compulsory Rotatory Resident Internship Training Programme. Before applying so, the facilities and departments with the staff members shall have to be provided by the management of the medical college as *prescribed by the Medical Council of India from time to time as per Annexure-II.*

27. The Inspection Commission sent by the University shall inspect the facilities made available by the management of the college and report to the University as to whether all the facilities required to be provided by the college are provided. The Inspection Commission shall also point out in its report the lacunae, if any, in the fulfillment of the conditions required to be fulfilled and also advise as to the capability of the college to rectify the lacunae within a period of two months. In case there are lacunae in the fulfillment of the conditions, the University may conduct such re-inspection on payment

of a sum of Rs.50,000/- (Rupees fifty thousand only) or such amount as may be prescribed by the Governing Council from time to time towards re-inspection fee and shall receive a final report from the Inspection Commission.

28. After a detailed examination of the final report of the Inspection Commission, if the University is fully satisfied as to the fulfillment of the conditions for the Continuance of Provisional Affiliation for the final M.B.B.S. degree course of study the University shall direct the management of the college to remit the Continuance of Provisional Affiliation fees of Rs.6,00,000/- for 50/100 admissions and Rs.9,00,000/- for 150 admissions respectively.

29. On receipt of the intimation from the applicant college that all the staff members appointed in pursuance of the above statutes are in a position to start the teaching course, the University shall, after collecting a sum of Rs.50,000/- (Rupees fifty thousand only) or such amount as may be prescribed by the Governing Council from time to time from the college towards the Continuance of Provisional Affiliation fee for the fifth batch including CRR1 of M.B.B.S. degree course of study and on production of Renewal Permission from the Government of India/Medical Council of India, grant Continuance of Provisional Affiliation for the fifth batch including CRR1 of M.B.B.S. degree course of study. It shall be competent for the University to withdraw the Provisional Affiliation granted herein by giving three months notice stating the reasons therefor to the management of the College.

30. (1) The Continuance of Provisional Affiliation granted above by the University shall be only for the Fifth batch of M.B.B.S. degree course of study. Thereupon the University shall permit the College to admit the students in the Fifth batch of M.B.B.S. degree course of study.

(2) The Medical College shall furnish a budget for each year of study and a separate development budget which will cover the expenses for the fulfillment of the requirements prescribed for the Compulsory Rotatory Resident Internship course of study.

31. The Medical College seeking Affiliation shall follow the course contents and regulations of the Medical Council of India as *modified from time to time*. The College shall also follow the

modifications in the course contents suggested by the Boards of Studies and Standing Academic Board of the University from time to time.

32. All the norms prescribed by the Medical Council of India shall be applied by the University in the area not covered by the regulations framed by the Tamil Nadu Dr.M.G.R. Medical University, Chennai for the starting of a new Medical College. Thereupon the University shall permit the College to admit the students in the Compulsory Rotatory Resident Internship training course of study.

33. It shall be competent for the University to inspect the Medical Colleges atleast once in five years to observe whether the quality of service, teaching and research properly maintained.

34. It shall be competent for the University to decide/change the venue of the Examination centre at its discretion and to send observers during Examination.

35. The College authorities shall send to the University a report regarding service, academic and research activities of the College and also annual staff return and vacancy position.

36. Thereafter, three months before the closure of every academic year, the management of the college shall make an application along with Inspection Proforma duly filled in writing to the University for grant of Continuance of Provisional Affiliation for conduct of the entire course of study during the next academic year along with the prescribed inspection fee and request the University to appoint an Inspection Commission to inspect the college for grant of Continuance of Provisional Affiliation for conduct of the entire course of study.

The University on receipt of such application shall appoint an Inspection Commission to inspect the college and to verify whether all the infrastructural facilities required for the conduct of the entire course of study are continued to be provided by the college. The Inspection Commission after inspecting the college duly verifying the Inspection Proforma shall submit a report to the University as to the continuance of all the required infrastructural facilities in the college of conduct of the entire course of study.

The University after detailed examination of the Inspection Report and if the University is fully satisfied as to the continuance of all the required infrastructural facilities for grant of Continuance of

Provisional Affiliation for conduct of the entire course of study, the University shall after collecting Continuance of Provisional Affiliation fees of Rs.3,00,000/- (Rupees three lakhs only) or such amount as may be fixed by the Governing Council from time to time towards the fee for the grant of Continuance of Provisional Affiliation for conduct of the entire course of study.

It shall be necessary for the management of the college to obtain the continuance of Provisional Affiliation to conduct the entire course of study, as stated above every year. The above provisions will be followed for granting Continuance of Provisional Affiliation for conduct of the entire course of study, every year,

It shall be competent for the University to withdraw the Provisional Affiliation granted herein for conduct of the entire course of study by giving 3 months notice stating the reasons therefor, to the management of the college and after considering the explanation submitted by the management of the college.

37. The Governing Council shall have the power after due enquiry to withdraw the Provisional Affiliation granted to a college, provided that before coming to such a decision, the Governing Council shall inform the governing body of the college concerned of its findings after enquiry and shall allow it an opportunity of making such representation as it may deem fit and shall record its opinion on the representation, so made.

38. It shall be competent for the University to send an Inspector at any time to inspect the Medical College without prior notice to the management of the college and on receipt of report from the Inspector, the University may take any decision which it deems fit and necessary.

39. The management of the affiliated college may apply to this University along with the approval of the Government of India/Medical Council of India for increase in seats in Under Graduate course upto a maximum of two hundred and fifty (250) seats only. Permission for increase in seats beyond two hundred and fifty will not be granted.

40. It shall be competent for the Governing Council to entertain or decline to entertain for reasons which shall be recorded in writing, the application received from the management of the medical college

for increase in the number of seats in the college subject to the ceiling specified in Statute No.39. The University will review the clinical facilities provided by the institutions and progress of clinical performance of the hospitals vis-a-vis the population potential around the hospital and public interest covered at large, while entertaining the application for increase of seats.

41. No medical college shall apply to the University for increase in seats until the first batch of students has successfully completed the course and left the college and the M.B.B.S. Degree so obtained is recognised by the Medical Council of India.

42. The management of the medical college shall satisfy the University regarding the following norms as prescribed by the University and the Medical Council of India in this regard from time to time while making application for increase in seats in Form No.IV annexed with these statutes.

- (i) proportionate increase in the staff pattern;
- (ii) proportionate increase in the equipment and laboratory facilities;
- (iii) proportionate increase in the accommodation; and
- (iv) expansion of library;
- (v) Inspection Proforma duly filled in

43. On receipt of the application from the management of the medical college for increase in seats, the University shall appoint an Inspection Commission to inspect the suitability of the facilities provided by the college for such increase in seats. A sum of Rs.50,000/- (Rupees fifty thousand only) or such amount as may be prescribed by the Governing Council from time to time, shall be paid by the management of the medical college, payable to the Tamil Nadu Dr.M.G.R. Medical University, Chennai towards inspection fee.

44. The Inspection Commission referred to in Statute 43 shall report to the University duly verifying the Inspection Proforma submitted by the Management as to whether all the requirements specified in statute 42 have been provided by the management of the college. The Inspection Commission shall also point out in its report the lacunae, if any, in the fulfillment of the requirements to be provided and also advise as to the capability of the management of the college to rectify the lacunae

within a period of two months. The University shall conduct re-inspection on payment of a sum of Rs.50,000/- (Rupees fifty thousand only) or such amount as may be prescribed by the Governing Council from time to time made by the management of the medical college, payable to the Tamil Nadu Dr.M.G.R. Medical University, Chennai, towards re-inspection fee and shall received a final report from the Inspection Commission.

45. On receipt of the final report of the above Inspection Commission and if the report is found satisfactory the University shall recommend to the Medical Council of India for its inspection and concurrence.

46. On receipt of the concurrence from the Medical Council of India to increase the seats in the college concerned the University shall grant permission to the college concerned to admit students in the seats so increased.

47. The permission granted to the management of the college by the University under Statute 46 is liable to be withdrawn if any of the norms prescribed in the Statute 42 is violated. In case of such withdrawal, the permission shall be restored only when a satisfactory report received by the University on an inspection that the norms prescribed in the Statute 42 have been duly complied with.

48. No affiliated institution shall apply to the University for increase in seats in under graduate course as well for starting of post graduate courses simultaneously. Such applications can be made only in different academic years.

49. Surprise inspection will be conducted by the University suo-motto or on complaints at any point of the year to confirm whether all such institutions are maintained in best condition as per Medical Council of India norms. If any deficiencies or major faults are noticed during the surprise inspection, action will be initiated to withdraw to Provisional Affiliation granted to the particular college/institution.

50. Failure to comply with the findings of the Surprise Inspection Commission will entail withdrawal of Provisional Affiliation granted.

51. The college/institution shall not enter into any Memorandum of Understanding with other Universities or any other organization without obtaining the prior permission from this University.

It shall be competent for the Governing council to entertain or decline to entertain for reasons which shall be recorded in writing, the application received from the affiliated Colleges for such permission.
