I am to inform that the Meeting of the Board of Studies in
Siddha Course was held on 25.11.2013 and discussed various
academic matters. The decisions of the Board of Studies in Siddha
Course was approved by the 47th meeting of the Standing
Academic Board, held on 18.12.2013 and passed in the 225th
Meeting of the Governing Council held on 07.01.2014 which are
detailed below:

1) THE AMENDMENT REGULATION, 2013 FOR CONDUCTING U.G. COURSE IN SIDDHA BY THE CENTRAL COUNCIL OF INDIAN MEDICINE, NEW DELHI.

Resolved to follow the Syllabus and the Regulations of undergraduate course framed by the Central Council of Indian Medicine. It will be applicable to the students admitted from the academic year 2013-2014.

2) THE GUIDELINES FOR DISSERTATION ACTIVITIES AND APPOINTMENT OF EXAMINERS TO EVALUATE THE DISSERTATION IN RESPECT OF M.D. SIDDHA DEGREE COURSE FORWARDED BY THE INSTITUTIONS.

Resolved to fix minimum of five years Teaching experience after completing postgraduate degree for both Internal and External Examiners for undergraduate course.

3) TO FOLLOW THE U.G. SYLLABUS OF 1st PROFESSIONAL BSMS COURSE BY THE CENTRAL COUNCIL OF INDIAN MEDICINE, NEW DELHI.

Resolved to follow the syllabus of 1st Professional BSMS course framed by the Central Council of Indian Medicine, New Delhi.

4) TO INFORM ABOUT THE IMPLEMENTATION OF GUIDELINES FOR DISSERTATION FOR ALL POST GRADUATE DEGREE COURSES FROM THE APRIL 2014 EXAMINATION ONWARDS, AS PER RESPECTIVE COUNCIL NORMS.

The action of the University framing guidelines for dissertation for all Post Graduate Degree Courses based on the norms of the respective Central Councils as approved by the 223rd Meeting of the Governing Council held on 26.9.2013, is ratified and the same be implemented from April 2014 examination onwards

From April 2014 Examination onwards, the certificate as below should be attached in addition to the existing certificates in the dissertations submitted as a part of their curriculum by all the candidates.

1. It was resolved that from **February 2014/ April 2014** session onwards, only single valuation will be done for all Undergraduate, Post Graduate and Super Speciality Degree courses unless the Double valuation is advised by the respective councils.

2. It has been resolved that, "once hall ticket is issued by the University to a candidate based on his/her application for Examination submitted along with necessary fee forwarded by the College, it will be treated as an attempt irrespective of the fact whether the candidate is actually appearing for the Examination or not due to any reason." Only when the candidate has taken up/appeared for any part of the Examination, it will be considered as an appearance.

3. From the April 2014 Examination session onwards, for all the Post Graduate Degree/Diploma courses, it has been decided to remove the component system of appearing in the Examination following the norms of the respective councils.

4. The fees for issue of Migration certificate need to be collected along with the Examination fees and the Migration certificates shall be issued on receipt of the application.

I am to request that the decision of the Standing Academic Board as mentioned above may be communicated to all the Professors and Heads of Departments for information and further follow up action in the regard. I am also to request that a copy of this letter may be displayed on the Notice Board of the College / Hostel for information of the students concerned.
