The Meeting of the Board of Studies in Fellowship in Dental(PG & Post Doctoral) was held on 20-11-13 and discussed various matters in the Curriculum, Regulation etc., The above recommendation of the Board of Studies in Fellowship in Dental(PG & Post Doctoral) were approved in the 47th Meeting of the Standing Academic Board held on 18-12-2013 and passed in Res.No.36, of the 225th meeting of the Governing Council held on 07.01.2014 are hereby communicated to take necessary further follow up action thereon.

1. In Fellowship in Dental Science courses, “If any candidate failed either in theory paper or practical, the candidate should appear in all the exams i.e. Theory, I.A., Clinical and Viva Voce.”

Resolved to add the following statement in the Scheme of Examination:

Note: A candidate must secure 50% for a pass in each component of the examination mentioned above independently **and also in aggregate.**

2. Resolved to approve the Regulations, Syllabus and Guidelines as recommended

by the Expert Committee with regard to Post-Doctoral Fellowship Programme in Maxillo Facial Distraction Osteogenesis.

Anyother items:-

1. Resolved that from **February 2014/ April 2014** session onwards, only single valuation will be done for all Undergraduate, Post Graduate and Super Speciality Degree courses unless the Double valuation is advised by the respective councils.

Guidelines for double valuations

- ⇒ **Answer scripts of the candidates who have failed in the first valuation will be subject to second valuation.**
- ⇒ **The average marks of the two valuations will be considered for processing the results.**
- ⇒ **If the difference of marks between the two valuations is more than 30%, then the answer scripts be subject to third valuation and the best of two valuations among the three will be considered for processing the results.**

2. Resolved that, “once hall ticket is issued by the University to a candidate based on his/her application for Examination submitted along with necessary fee forwarded by the College, it will be treated as an attempt irrespective of the fact whether the candidate is actually appearing for the Examination or not due to any reason.” Only when the candidate has taken up/appeared for any part of the Examination, it will be considered as an appearance.

3. From the April 2014 Examination session onwards, for all the Post Graduate Degree/Diploma and super speciality courses, it has been decided to remove the component system of appearing in the Examination following the norms of the respective councils.

4. The fees for issue of Migration certificate need to be collected along with the Examination fees and the Migration certificates shall be issued on receipt of the application.

The above decisions are communicated for information and to take necessary action. The Principals are also requested to circulate the above matters among the Professors/Head of the Department/Students of their college and also to display it in the College Notice Board and the Department Notice Board for information of the student.
