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The Meeting of the Board of Studies in Allied Health Science (UG and Dip Courses) was held on 04.12.201 and recommended various matters in the Curriculum, Regulation etc., which were approved in the 47th meeting of the Standing Academic Board held on 18-12-2013 and passed in Resolution No.36, of the 225th meeting of the Governing Council held on 07.01.2014 are hereby communicated to take necessary further follow up action.

TO CONSIDER THE MODIFICATIONS IN THE SYLLABUS FOR (I) B.SC. RADIOLOGY IMAGING TECHNOLOGY, (ii) DIPLOMA IN RADIOLOGY IMAGING TECHNOLOGY (iii) B.Sc. RADIOTHERAPY TECHNOLOGY UNDER ALLIED HEALTH SCIENCE

Resolved to approve the recommendations of the Expert Committee with regard syllabus revamping for the courses (I) B.Sc. Radiology Imaging Technology (ii) Diploma in Radiology Imaging Technology (iii) B.Sc. Radiotherapy Technology Courses. The total number of working is 240 days (instead of 270 days) as per other Allied Health U.G. Courses. The teaching hours shall be reduced suitably.

B.Sc. Radiology & Imaging Technology. there is no change in teaching hours (75 hrs.) in III year, Paper III “Quality Control, Radiobiology and Radiation Safety in Radio diagnosis / Imaging”.

Resolved that the candidates who have completed +2 with Diploma will be exempted to do 1st year and can enter directly to the second year in B.Sc Radiology and Imaging Technology course.

Hereafter the nomenclature of “Radiology & Imaging Technology” only will be used in substitute of the nomenclature “Radio Diagnosis Technology” exist from the academic year 2014-2015 onwards.

TO CONSIDER AND DECIDE ON THE INTRODUCTION OF B.SC. RESPIRATORY THERAPY COURSE UNDER ALLIED HEALTH SCIENCE COURSE.

The syllabus prepared by the Expert Committee has been assessed and suggested the following changes:

Eligibility : +2 Pass with Physics, Chemistry and Biology.

Regarding passing criteria for examination, the University norms to be followed.

(The Syllabus contents may kindly be seen in the University Web Site).

Any other items

1. For all paramedical courses having councils such as RCI, AERB, etc. the University will follow the Rules & Regulations, Examination Pattern, etc. specified by the Councils.

Unless specified by the Councils the candidates appearing for final year examination should have cleared the previous years papers.

In all paramedical courses. the candidates should complete the course within double the duration from date of joining the course.

2. Representations received from Dr. A. Muraleedharan, (Board of Studies Member) with regard BASLP course:

The Board approved the following:

(i) To follow the carry over passing system as per the RCI norms from the academic year 2013-2014 onwards.

(ii) Regarding the request for change in the year of appearance for the Paper on subject - Statistics and Research Methods Related to Speech Therapy - to follow the syllabus as per the RCI norms from the academic year 2013-2014 onwards.

(iii) The request placed regarding the examination for the candidates admitted in 2010-2011 & 2011-2012 batches of Madras Medical College, Chennai (Results not yet published). For those candidates failing subjects can be carried over their subjects to the next year instead of break system (RCI norms). This is implemented as one time measure for the welfare of the candidates.

3. Appointment of Examiners for all paramedical courses, the Board approved the following decisions:

a. For 'Undergraduate Degree': Assistant Professor in concerned specialty with three years teaching experience.

b. For U.G Diploma courses: Assistant Professor in concerned specialty.

4. Regarding Practical examination, the minimum number of candidate for Home Centre is five. If the strength is less than five candidates, the practical examinations may be clubbed with nearby institution.

5. Representation received from Ishwar Institute of Prosthetics & Orthotics, the Board resolved the following:

1. Scientific Calculator should not be used during the examination (As per the RCI norms).

2. Allowed to use A2 paper for drawing examinations.

3. To follow the Regulations and syllabus as per RCI norms.

6. It was resolved that from **February 2014/ April 2014** session onwards, only single valuation will be done for all Undergraduate, Post Graduate and Super Speciality Degree courses unless the Double valuation is advised by the respective councils.

7. It has been resolved that, "once hall ticket is issued by the University to a candidate based on his/her application for Examination submitted along with necessary fee forwarded by the College, it will be treated as an attempt irrespective of the fact whether the candidate is actually appearing for the Examination or not due to any reason." Only when the candidate has taken up/appeared for any part of the Examination, it will be considered as an appearance.

The Principals are requested to circulate the above matters among the Professors/Head of the Department/Student of their college and also to display it in the College Notice Board and the Department Notice Board for information of the student.
