I am to inform that the Board of Studies in Allied Health Science PG Courses in its meeting held on 20.06.2014 have recommended various matters in the Curriculum, Regulation etc. relating to PG Degree / Diploma under Allied Health Courses . The recommendation of the Board of Studies were placed in the 48<sup>th</sup> meeting of the Standing Academic Board held on 02.07.2014 and the same was approved in Resolution No.27, in the meeting of the Governing Council held on 24.07.2014.

The recommendation of the Board of Studies in Allied Health Sciences PG Degree / Diploma Course are as follows:

**TO DISCUSS AND DECIDE ON THE RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE EXPERT COMMITTEE CONSTITUTED FOR FRAMING OF SYLLABUS, REGULATION AND GUIDELINES FOR THE PROPOSED M.SC (MEDICAL MICROBIOLOGY) AND M.SC. (MEDICAL BIOCHEMISTRY) COURSES.**

The Board approved the Syllabus, Regulation and Guidelines for the M.Sc. (Medical Microbiology) and M.Sc. (Medical Biochemistry). This will be implemented from the Academic Year 2015-16 onwards. The approved Syllabus is uploaded in the University website.

## ATTENDANCE REQUIRED FOR ADMISSION TO EXAMINATION

This will be implemented from the year academic year 2015-2016.

## **TO DISCUSS AND DECIDE ON THE RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE EXPERT COMMITTEE CONSTITUTED FOR REVAMPING OF SYLLABUS, REGULATION AND GUIDELINES FOR THE PROPOSED MBA IN HOSPITAL AND HEALTH SYSTEM MANAGEMENT COURSES.**

The Board resolved that the Institution cannot run the MBA course without the approval of AICTE from the Academic year 2014-2015 onwards.

It is also resolved that the university will conduct the MBA course if the syllabus is different from that of MHA course and with AICTE approval.

The Members approved the above agenda and revamping of Syllabus, Regulation and Guidelines for the proposed MHA in Hospital and Health System Management courses.
