The Board has resolved to implement the following practical Examination scheme
for Post Graduate Diploma in Public Health course:

The duration of practical exams for DPH course is scheduled for 2 days for each candidate.

The above scheme of examination to be implemented prospectively from 2015-2016 admission onwards.

Further, it is resolved that the Clinical Legal Conference (CLC) can be conducted by the Forensic Department in co-ordination with all other departments in the Medical Colleges atleast four per year. This has to be implemented from the academic year 2016-17 onwards.
