on 09-05-2019 and discussed various academic matters. The decisions of the Board of  
Studies in Siddha Course was approved in the 57<sup>th</sup> meeting of the Standing  
Academic Board, held on 04-06-2019 and recorded in Resolution No:21 in the 270<sup>th</sup>  
Meeting of the Governing Council held on 30-07-2019 which are detailed below:

**POINT NO:1**

**DISCUSS AND DECIDE ON THE CLARIFICATIONS SUBMITTED BY  
DR.J.JAGANATHAN, PRINCIPAL, SIVARAJ SIDDHA MEDICAL COLLEGE, SALEM.**

- The Board of Studies accepts the recommendations of the Expert Committee with regard to II Year Syllabus of BSMS Degree Course Gunapadam –I (Marunthiyal) for implementation from October 2019 Examination onwards.
- The Board of Studies recommends that Practical Examination pattern (duration 3 hours) for BSMS II Udal Thatuvam be followed as per the existing norms of Central Council of Indian Medicine, New Delhi.

**POINT No.2**

**DISCUSS AND DECIDE ON THE NOMENCLATURE IN THE DEGREE CERTIFICATE  
OF INDIAN MEDICINE COURSES AS PRESCRIBED BY THE CENTRAL COUNCIL OF  
INDIAN MEDICINE, NEW DELHI.**

The Board of Studies discussed on the format of Degree Certificate circulated by Central Council of Indian Medicine, New Delhi and opines that the existing Degree Certificate format be followed to have uniformity in degree certificates given by this university. The board further recommends to inform the CCIM, New Delhi with regard to the degree certificate pattern being followed by this university.

**The Standing Academic Board has resolved to write to Central Council of Indian Medicine, New Delhi appraising of the facts of practical intricacy at the university level with regard to change of format of Degree Certificates as per the letter No.7-100/2018 dated 17-12-2018 of Central Council of Indian Medicine, New Delhi as recommended by Board of Studies.**

### **POINT NO:3**

#### **RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE EXPERT COMMITTEE ON THE II YEAR SYLLABUS IN SIDDHA DEGREE COURSE PASSED IN ITS MEETING HELD ON 26-04-2019.**

The Board of Studies accepts the recommendations of the Expert Committee with regard to the II Year Syllabus of BSMS Degree Course (Gunapadam).

#### **POINT No.4 - REGARDING APPLICATIONS FOR ELIGIBILITY CERTIFICATE**

**DISCUSS AND DECIDE ON THE COLLECTION OF PENAL FEE FOR ISSUE OF ELIGIBILITY CERTIFICATES TO CANDIDATES WHO HAVE JOINED THE UG/PG COURSES WITH IN THE STIPULATED CUT OFF DATE, BUT HAVE APPLIED FOR ELIGIBILITY CERTIFICATE BELATEDLY BY MORE THAN TWO MONTHS**

**Based on the discussion, the SAB has resolved that the existing penal fee would continue to be followed for those who apply for Eligibility Certificate belatedly. Also, resolved to instruct all the affiliated institutions to ensure that students are sensitized about the importance of submitting EC along with other relevant documents to the University for Registration.**

#### **POINT No.5 - REGARDING AYUSH (U.G.) ADMISSIONS BASED ON NEET**

**INFORM ABOUT THE MINISTRY OF AYUSH DIRECTIVE TO ADMIT STUDENTS IN AYUSH UNDER GRADUATE COURSES FROM THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2019-2020, ONLY ON THE BASIS OF MERIT LIST OF NATIONAL ELIGIBILITY CUM ENTRANCE TEST (U.G.)-2019 EXCEPT IN BNYS DEGREE COURSE WHICH IS NOT GOVERNED UNDER THE CCIM/CCH REGULATIONS.**

The Standing Academic Board has resolved to implement the directions of the Ministry of AYUSH issued vide letter No. Lr.No.F.NO.R.14011/06/2018-EP-II dated 25.02.2019, to admit students in AYUSH Under Graduate Courses BAMS,BUMS,BSMS,BHMS (except BNYS Degree Courses) from the academic year 2019-2020 on the basis of merit list of National Eligibility cum Entrance Test (UG)-2019.

I am to request that the decision of the Standing Academic Board as mentioned above may be communicated to all the Professors and Heads of Departments for information and further follow up action in the regard. I am also to request that a copy of this letter may be displayed on the Notice Board of the College / Hostel for information of the students concerned.
