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I am to inform you that Meeting of the Board of Studies in Nursing Degree Courses was held on 14.05.2019 and discussed various academic matters in respect of Nursing Degree courses. The decision of the Board of Studies in Nursing courses were approved by the SAB at 57th meeting held on 04/06/2019. The following recommendation of the SAB was approved by the Governing Council, vide resolution No.21 passed at the 270th meeting held on 30.07.2019.

Point No.1

TO DECIDE ON THE IMPLEMENTATION OF INTEGRATION OF MIDDLE LEVEL HEALTH PROVIDER EVALUATION IN BASIC B.Sc.,(NURSING) AND POST B.Sc., NURSING CURRICULUM AS PER THE INDIAN NURSING COUNCIL CIRCULAR DATED 12.02.2019.

The Standing Academic Board has resolved to implement the recommendations of Expert Committee Meeting held on 26-03-2019 with regard to implementation of integration of Middle Level Health Provider concepts, roles and responsibilities in the Basic B.Sc. (Nursing) and the Post Basic B.Sc. II Year Nursing curriculum as directed by the Indian Nursing Council , New Delhi circular F No.1- 2/NEC/2019-INC dated 12-02-2019.

Further, resolved that the concepts, roles and responsibilities of MLHP to be completed and entered in the log book during the fourth year Integrated Community Health Nursing Practice. It is to be implemented by the affiliated institutions for B.Sc. (Nursing) students who will enter into fourth year in the academic year 2019-2020 and for Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing students who will enter into second year in the academic year 2019-2020 as recommended by the Expert Committee. Model log book to enter skills of MLHP is available in the INC Website for reference and implementation.

Point No. 3

TO IMPLEMENT THE INDIAN NURSING COUNCIL, NOTIFICATION NO. F. NO. 1- 5/2018-INC DATED 15.03.2019, FOR GRANTING OF MERCY CHANCE/RELAXATION OF MAXIMUM TIME PERIOD IN NURSING DEGREE COURSES FOR THOSE CANDIDATES WHO ARE UNABLE TO COMPLETE THE COURSE IN THE PRESCRIBED TIME LIMIT i.e. BEYOND DOUBLE THE DURATION OF THE COURSE.

The Board of Studies discussed with regard to implementation of the Indian Nursing Council Notification No.F.No.1-5/2018-INC dated 15.03.2019 for granting of mercy chance/relaxation of maximum period of time for those candidates who are unable to complete Nursing course in prescribed time limit (i.e double the duration of the course). In this connection, The Indian Nursing Council has resolved as follows :

“Maximum time limit for completing nursing course can be relaxed subject to the condition that, such candidates qualify a basic examination conducted (for the purpose) by the respective State Nursing Council in order to be allowed to continue the course/appear in the University Examination”.

The SAB has resolved to implement the Indian Nursing Council notification dated 15-03-2019.

Point No: 4

TO DISCUSS AND DECIDE ON THE AGENDA FORWARDED BY THE PRINCIPAL, OMayal Achi College of Nursing, Chennai, Regarding B.Sc (Nursing) & M.Sc.(Nursing) Degree Courses.

a) with regard to inclusion of gender and inclusion of Distinction/First Class in the Degree certificate of B.Sc (Nursing) & M.Sc (Nursing) awarded by the Tamil Nadu Dr. MGR Medical University, the Board of Studies recommends to follow the existing pattern of award of degree certificate.

b) With regard to minimum period to be given for entering the internal assessment marks through online by the institution, the Board of studies recommends to allow a minimum period of five days to enter the internal assessment marks through online.

c) With regard to Higher Secondary Certificate (HSC) verification, the Board of Studies informed that the university is currently doing online HSc verification for all students of affiliated institutions and if there is any issue the university will inform the concerned institutions.

d) Regarding log-book completion as a mandatory requirement for appearing University Practical Examination, the BOS recommends that a communication may once again be sent to all the nursing institutions affiliated to this Academic Board and university as resolved in the 50th Standing also upload this information in the university website.

The Standing Academic Board has resolved to accept the recommendation of Board of Studies.

I request that the decision of the Standing Academic Board as mentioned above may be communicated to all the Professors and Heads of the Departments of your Institution for information and further follow up action in this regard. I am also to request that the copy of this letter may be displayed on the Notice Board of the College / Hostel for the information of the students concerned.
