Board Meeting held on 17-12-2019 and recorded in Resolution No.14 of
the 274th Meeting of the Governing council held on 22-01-2020.

I am to inform that the Meeting of the Board of Studies in Ayurveda Course was
held on 25-11-2019 and discussed various academic matters. The decisions of the Board
of Studies in Ayurveda Course was approved in the 58th meeting of the Standing
Academic Board, held on 17-12-2019 and recorded in Resolution No:24 in the 274th
Meeting of the Governing Council held on 22-01-2020 which are detailed below:

POINT NO: 1

DISCUSS AND DECIDE ON THE INDIAN MEDICINE CENTRAL COUNCIL(MINIMUM
STANDARDS OF EDUCATION IN INDIAN MEDICINE)AMENDMENT REGULATIONS,
2019 DATED 18-06-2019 PRESCRIBED BY THE CENTRAL COUNCIL OF INDIAN
MEDICINE, NEW DELHI TO BE IMPLEMENTED FROM 18TH JUNE 2019 BASED ON
THE GAZETTE NOTIFICATION FOR UG DEGREE COURSES.

The Standing Academic Board has resolved that the recommendations pertaining to removal of Cerebral Palsy and Muscular Dystrophy from the list of Gazette Notification dated 18-6-2019 cannot be considered since it pertains to the CCIM eligibility criteria.

1) It was decided that the Chairman, Board of Studies has to submit the updated list of Internal/External Examiners. The Minimum eligibility for Internal/External Examinership is three years of teaching experience on the concerned or allied subjects as per CCIM Norms. The Moderators and Paper setters should have at least five years experience and they should be from the concerned specialities.

The updated list of Examiners can be submitted to the University which in turn will be validated by the Board Members and be submitted to the University by the Chairman.

The Standing Academic Board has approved the above agenda.

2) Dr. Shaik Aleem suggested for faculties working under this University from other states, the University is asking the Registration Certificate of the Tamil Nadu, inspite of their Registration in their own states.

Currently, the CCIM is permitting the Central Registration along with the Registration in the respective state in this concern. Hence, University can consider to adopt the recommendations of CCIM in this regard.

The Standing Academic Board has resolved that the faculties from other states who are working in affiliated institutions of this University should have registered in Tamilnadu State Council/Directorate of Indian Medicine.

I am to request that the decision of the Standing Academic Board as mentioned above may be communicated to all the Professors and Heads of Departments for information and further follow up action in the regard. I am also to request that a copy of this letter may be displayed on the Notice Board of the College / Hostel for information of the students concerned.
