I am to inform you that the minutes of the meeting of the Board of Studies in Pharmacy Degree Courses held on 05.04.2021 was recommended by the Standing Academic Board, at the 60th meeting held on 29.04.2021. The following recommendations of the Standing Academic Board was approved by the Governing Council at the 282nd meeting held on 19.07.2021. The Standing Academic Board has resolved that:

POINT NO.1

1. To follow the PCI Norms of not awarding grace marks to the Semester Pattern of B.Pharm candidates.
2. To adhere to the norms of PCI for passing system for Non Semester students.
3. To have one Internal Examiner for Pharmaceutical Chemistry, Pharmaceutical Analysis & Pharmacy Practice in M.Pharm I Semester.
4. Institutions to issue attempt certificate on request by the candidates.
5. Appointment of Inspectors is not within the purview of Board of Studies.
6. To continue with the existing system of appointment of Moderators.
7. To continue the existing Virtual Evaluation.

8. To follow the existing Guidelines meticulously for issue of Guideship for faculty in Pharmacy Institutions.

9. To conduct Virtual Examination for M.Pharm Final Year (IV Semester) Examinations (Project only), due to the current Pandemic Situation.

POINT NO.2 & 3

1. To continue with the existing method of distribution of remuneration through Head of the Institutions for Theory Examinations.

2. With regard to Pharmaco – Vigilance Center, the Board recommended to write to the University separately.

The Standing Academic Board cannot decide on selection of students under the category of Tuition Fee Waiver (TFW), Economically Weaker Section (EWS) & J&K seats since the matter is not under the purview of University.

POINT NO.4

- To follow the Pharmacy Council of India norms for teaching faculties in Anatomy and Physiology in B.Pharm and Pharm D courses and to modify the Inspection Format accordingly.
- To remove the option of entering the credit points in online internal assessment entry as the credit points is the same for all students in a subject.
- To have a single entry for online submission of Internal Assessment to the University as resolved in 59th Meeting of Standing Academic Board held on 16.09.2020.
- To continue with the existing method of online submission of Attendance to the University.
- To submit mark entries as whole numbers and not in decimals as resolved in 59th Meeting of Standing Academic Board held on 16.09.2020.

Further, I am also to request that the decision of the Standing Academic Board as mentioned above be communicated to all the Professors and Head of the Departments of your institution for information, and a copy of this letter be displayed on the Notice Board of the College / Hostel for the information of the students.
