I am to inform you that, the minutes of the meeting of the Board of Studies in PG Medical Pre & Para Clinical Degree courses held on 10.10.2024 was recommended by the Standing Academic Board, at the 63rd meeting held on 21.11.2024. The following recommendations of the Standing Academic Board was approved by the Governing Council at the 303rd meeting held on 28.11.2024. The Standing Academic Board has resolved as follows:

1. To follow the revamped Guidelines of Post Graduate Medical Education Regulation 2023 (PGMER-2023) Regulation of National Medical Commission, New Delhi which was published on 29-12-2023 and FAQ on PGMER – 2023 on 10-04-2024.
2. To approve the modification suggested by the Expert Committee with regard to Scheme of Practical Examination for MD Community Medicine.

Practical Examination should be spread over two days. It should include the following components. This Scheme of Examination will be implemented from December 2024 examination onwards.

3. To ratify the action taken for implementation of Two Valuation Guidelines as per the PGMER -2023 Guidelines and published on 29-12-2023 in the Gazette of India, Part III Section -4 pg no.40.
4. To provide copy of the evaluated answer sheets along with marks to the students on request.
5. Accordingly, the photo copy of the answer scripts will be provided with distribution of marks for each answer, to the failed candidates.
6. Henceforth the university can accept Endowment for medal, only if students of all the affiliated institutions are allowed to participate in the medal examination.

7. The module for the mandated course in GCP, GLP, BCLS and ACLS will be prepared and Training of the PGs to be done for two days Region Wise i.e five region for the entire state as detailed below:

- The Tamilnadu Dr.MGR Medical University
- Madurai Medical College, Madurai
- PSG Institute of Medical Sciences & Research, Coimbatore
- Christian Medical College, Vellore
- Trichy SRM Medical College & Hospital and Research Centre, Trichy

Depending upon the number of PGs, the regional center will be nominated. The certificate will be issued by the University to maintain the uniformity among all the Affiliated institutions. The certificate issued by the university is mandatory for PGs to be eligible to appear for the University examination.

8. To conduct Research Methodology Workshop also Region Wise.

9. To structured curriculum for PG as follows:

- Integrated teaching sessions along with Clinical Specialties to be conducted once in a month.
- Assessments to be conducted four per year and the result to be sent to the University immediately.
- Separate hours (12 hours per year) for AETCOM training must be implemented.
- Mentors can be assigned for each Post Graduate student.

I am to request that the decision of the Standing Academic Board as mentioned above be communicated to all the Professors and Head of Departments of your Institution for information and a copy of this letter be displayed on the Notice Board of the College/Hostel for the information of the Students.
