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I am to inform that in the 40<sup>th</sup> Meeting of the Standing Academic  
Board held on 22.12.2010, the following academic issues relating to Medical,  
Dental, Indian Medicine and Homoeopathy and Allied Health Science degree  
courses, have been passed.

1) RE-INTROUCTION OF AWARD OF GRACE MARKS (UP TO A  
MAXIMUM OF FIVE MARKS IN THEORY PAPERS FOR UNDER GRADUATE &  
POST GRADUATE DEGREE/DIPLOMA AND SUPER SPECIALITY DEGREE  
COURSES

The awarding of grace marks upto a maximum of five marks in  
theory papers to the students of Under-graduate. Post graduate in Medical,  
Dental, Indian Medicine and Homoeopathy, Allied Health Sciences and Super  
Speicality courses be re-introduced from February/April 2011 examination  
onwards. The grace marks of five(5) shall be awarded in one subject or shall be  
distributed among the other two or three subjects. No Grace marks shall be  
awarded for Practical Examination for all courses.

2) PRESCRIBED INDIVIDUAL PASS IN EACH PAPER FOR ALL  
UNDER GRADUATE IN MEDICAL, DENTAL, INDIAN MEDICINE AND  
HOMOEOPATHY AND ALLIED HEALTH SCIENCE COURSES IN LIEU OF  
AGGREGATE MARKS

All Under graduate courses in Medical, Dental, Indian Medicine and Homoeopathy and Allied Health Science courses , if a subject is divided into two papers the candidate has to secure the minimum pass marks of 50% in each paper, otherwise he/she has to again appear for the subject with two papers including clinical/practical examination,

The above resolution will come into effect from August 2011 examination onwards.

**3) PRESCRIBED SEPARATE PASS IN SECTION 'A' & 'B' WHERE TWO SUBJECTS ARE COMBINED IN SINGLE PAPER IN MEDICAL, DENTAL, INDIAN MEDICINE AND HOMOEOPATHY AND ALLIED HEALTH SCIENCE COURSES**

The candidate has to secure a minimum separate pass mark of 50% each in Section 'A' and 'B' where two subjects are combined in single paper in Medical, Dental, Indian Medicine and Homoeopathy and Allied Health Sciences courses.

Further that if the candidate has failed to secure the minimum pass mark of 50% either in section A or B, the candidate has to write again both the sections irrespective of the facts whether the candidate has passed in one section. This will come into effect from August 2011 examination onwards.

**4) TO FURNISH THE FRESH INTERNAL ASSESSMENT MARKS BY THE INSTITUTIONS TO ARREAR STUDENTS OF ALL UNDER GRADUATE COURSES**

The fresh Internal Assessment marks has to furnish by the institution to arrear students of all undergraduate degree courses (Medical, Dental, Indian Medicine and Homoeopathy and Allied Health sciences) from August 2011 examination onwards.

The candidate has to secure a minimum of 50% separately (Rounded off to next highest integer ) in written (Theory), Practical/Clinical, Oral, Internal Assessment and Record in each subject for all under graduate courses in Dental, Indian Medicine and Homoeopathy and Allied Health Sciences also. This will come into effect from August 2011 examination onwards.

Further it was resolved that for Under graduate and Post graduate students of all the courses, at the end of every year, the attendance particulars of the students should be submitted to this University through online. At the end of final year all the three years attendance of the students should be submitted to this University. This will come into effect from August 2011 examination onwards.

**5) ISSUE OF ' NO OBJECTION CERTIFICATE TO THE CANDIDATES WHO ARE SEEKING TRANSFER OF INTERNSHIP FROM ONE INSTITUTION TO ANOTHER INSTITUTION**

'No Objection Certificate' will be issued to all the students who are seeking transfer of Internship from one institution to another institution as and when the students approach the University for academic (or) personal reasons. The revision of fees is as follows:-

The above resolution has already come into force from 1<sup>st</sup> January 2011 onwards.

**6) TO DISCHARGE THE CANDIDATES WHO HAVE COMPLETED DOUBLE THE DURATION OF THEIR RESPECTIVE COURSES**

To discharge all the Under Graduate, Post Graduate and Super Speciality candidates who have not completed the course within the double the duration of the respective courses in Medicine, Dental/Indian Medicine and Homoeopathy and Allied Health Science courses.

Further that as a measure of amnesty, to those who are on the final year of the respective courses, as a last chance, to appear for the Examination in February/August 2011 Examinations, be given and if any of them do not pass the course even in their last chance they may be discharged from the course. After getting necessary undertaking from the students and only then the Examination wing has to permit the students to appear for the Examinations.

The above resolution will come into effect from February/April 2011 Examination onwards.

**7) TO WITHDRAW THE SYSTEM OF ISSUE OF PHOTO COPIES OF ANSWER SHEETS TO THE FAILED CANDIDATES OF ALL UNDER GRADUATE AND POST GRADUATE COURSES**

The University has decided to withdraw the system of issuing Photocopy of answer sheets to the failed candidates of Under-graduate, Post graduate, Diploma/Degree and Super- specialities from February 2011 Examination onwards.

I am to request that the decision of the Standing Academic Board as mentioned above may be communicated to all the Professors and Heads of Departments for information and to take follow up action in this regard.

I am also to request that a copy may be displayed on the Notice Board of the College/Hostel for information of the students concerned.

I request that the receipt of this letter may be acknowledged by return of post.
