I am to inform that the Board of Studies in Post Graduate M.D.S in
the Meeting held on 09.11.2010 has recommended various academic issues
relating to M.D.S courses. The recommendations of the Board of Studies in

M.D.S course were approved in the 40th Meeting of the Standing Academic Board held on 22.12.2010.

1) PRESCRIBED INDIVIDUAL PASS IN EACH PAPER FOR
POST GRADUATE DENTAL COURSE IN LIEU OF
AGGREGATE MARKS

The candidate of Post Graduate Dental Degree course has to secure the minimum pass mark of 50% in each paper in lieu of aggregate marks. The guidelines for passing the examination of Post Graduate Dental Degree course is as follows.

a) A candidate who has passed in Clinical/Practical examination, but failed in one theory paper , has to write that particular theory paper alone in the subsequent supplementary examinations and to pass that theory paper. If the candidate fails again in that theory paper or does not appear for the subsequent supplementary examinations, then the candidate has to take up the entire examinations of all theory papers including Clinical/Practical examinations.

b) A candidate who has passed in Clinical/Practical examinations but has failed in two or more theory papers, the candidate has to take up the entire examinations of all theory papers including Clinical/Practical examinations.

c) A candidate who has failed in Clinical/Practical examinations, but has passed in all Theory papers, the candidate has to take up the entire examination including Clinical/Practical examinations.

This will come into effect from April 2011 examination onwards.

2, PUBLICATION OF e-JOURNAL BY M.D.S POST GRADUATE DEGREE STUDENTS

Publication of e-journal for Post Graduate students was inadvertently mentioned hence the chapter of publication of e-journal resolved in the 39th Meeting of the Standing Academic Board held on 21.06.2010 has been deleted.

3. APPLIED BASIC SCIENCES

For the betterment of the students and improvement of knowledge the Applied Basic Sciences Exam to be conducted at the end of the first year of the M.D.S Degree course instead of Basic Sciences Examination.

This will be applicable for the students who are appearing for the April 2011 examination onwards.

I am to request that the above decision of the Standing Academic Board as mentioned as above may be communicated to all the Professors and Head of Departments for information and further follow - up action in this regard.
