M.S (OPHTHALMOLOGY) DEGREE COURSE

- 1) Part I Theory: There has been no paper on General Surgery which has been discontinued for the past 5 years. Hence there is no need to have general surgery as a theory paper.
- 2) Regarding the postings, it has been approved by the PG Clinical Board held on 11/08/2011, that the postings in GH may be transferred to the second year and the postings of the candidates to these specialities. (15 days each in Neurology, Neuro surgery and Diabetology) rests with the discretion of the Head of the department of the concerned.
