The Meeting of the Board of Studies in AHS(PG) Courses was held on 09-12-11 and recommended various matters in the Curriculum, Regulation etc., which were approved in the 43rd meeting of the Standing Academic Board held on 19-12-2011 and are hereby communicated to take necessary further follow up action.

The Board of Studies recommends the following AHS(PG) degree Courses.

- 1. THE RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE EXPERT COMMITTEE MEETING
IN M.SC.,(MEDICAL PHYSICS) TO REVISE THE REGULATION AND
SYLLABUS PASSED AT ITS MEETING HELD ON 25TH AUGUST 2011.**

The members resolved to bring the following changes in the Regulation of MSc Medical Physics 2010-2011:

REGULATION NO.3:MINIMUM QUALIFICATION FOR ADMISSION:-

It is resolved that B.Sc Physics candidates through regular stream of university education are alone eligible for admission to MSc (Medical Physics) and resolved to delete the word Applied Physics. The candidates who studies B.Sc Physics through correspondence and open university stream of university education are not eligible.

REGULATION NO.7 CUT-OFF DATES FOR ADMISSION TO THE EXAMINATION:-

The candidates admitted 31st May/31st October of the Academic year will be registered to take up their first year M.Sc.,(Medical Physics) examination after fulfillment of the regulations in April of the Academic year.

REGULATION NO. 10 COMMENCEMENT OF THE COURSE:

The course will commence from 2nd May/1st October of the Academic Year.

REGULATION NO.11 COMMENCEMENT OF EXAMINATION:

There shall be two University examinations in an academic year. The annual Examinations will commence from April 15th and the Supplementary Examinations will commence from October 15th of every academic year.

REGULATION NO. 19 (DISSERTATION AND EVALUATION)

The board has resolved to adopt the following pattern for dissertation and agree to 50% aggregate as pass mark :

Dissertation	- 200
Presentation/IA	- 50
Viva/Orals	- 50

REGULATION NO. 29 : VACATION:

It was resolved to not to give vacation for a period of 6 weeks as per the university communication dated. Hence the word "Vacation 6 weeks' may be deleted.

REGULATION NO. 33 : SUBJECT OF STUDY – FIRST YEAR SUBJECT STUDY

It is resolved to include Viva-voce examination related to practical subject.

SECOND YEAR OF STUDY :

It is resolved to include the practical along with subject of “Advanced Technique in Radiotherapy” instead of “ Radiation Safety” subject. It is also resolved to have viva-voce examination for all practical subjects. Maximum mark - 50 - Minimum mark to pass 25.

It is resolved to include ‘Project along with Viva-voce examination’ as one of the subject in the scheme of examination.

THIRD YEAR OF STUDY:

It is resolved to include the subject wise split-up details for Compulsory Residency Training in the regulation and also resolved that the students must produce the provisional pass certificate from the university to commence their Compulsory Residency Training Programme.

It is resolved to include the list of practical experiments in the syllabus as directed by Atomic Energy Regulatory Board.

Any other items:

The members resolved that the candidates for practical examination per day may be restricted to maximum 5.

2. TO REVISE THE ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR MBA HOSPITAL AND HEALTH SYSTEM MANAGEMENT COURSE UNDER ALLIED HEALTH SCIENCE COURSES FROM THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2011-12 ONWARDS.

The board has resolved to approve the eligibility criteria for MBA Hospital and Health System Management to be revised to include B.Sc.,(Microbiology) and other Life Science Courses from the academic year 2011-2012 onwards.

3. TO IMPLEMENT FOR AWARDING OF MARKS TO THE DISSERTATION UNIFORMLY FOR ALL PG COURSES UNDER ALLIED HEALTH SCIENCES.

The board has resolved to adopt the following pattern for dissertation and agree to 50% aggregate as pass mark :

Dissertation	- 200
Presentation/IA	- 50
Viva/Orals	- 50

4. TO CONSIDER FOR INCLUDING THE SUBJECTS IN I & II YEAR OF SYLLABUS IN M.SC.,(MEDICAL SOCIOLOGY) POST GRADUATE DEGREE COURSE UNDER THE REGULATION 2010-11.

The board has resolved to include a chapter in I & II year of syllabus for students admitted from the academic year 2012-2013 in MSc (Medical Sociology) under 2010-2011 regulation.

Ist Year: Paper III - Health Policy and Health Care Delivery

Quality and differences in Health: Rural, Urban, Class and Gender; Evolution of Social Medicine in India, Traditional, Modern and Alternative Medicine.

IInd Year: Paper No.IV - Medical Ethics and Laws:

1. Overview of Judicial system in India: DCA, FDA, Clinical Trails, Objectives; global scenario, why the focus is on India?
2. Introduction to regulatory authorities in India: Drug Controller General of India, Indian Council of Medical Research, History Organisation Scope statement of General Principles in Biomedical Research involving Human Subject Statement of General Principle Specific Principles ethical review procedured, Genetic Engineering Approval Committee composition, Department of Biotechnology, Objectives, Organisation: Atomic Energy Regulatory Board, Objectives, organisation, Acts and Rules; Directorate General of Foreign Trade; The drug technical Advisory Board; Indian Regulatory Approval Process; Regulatory Time lines.

5. TO INFORM THE COMMENCEMENT OF EXAMINATION DATES FOR THE TWO CUT OFF DATES FIXED FOR PG IN ALLIED HEALTH SCIENCES FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2011-12 AND IN FUTURE.

RESOLVED TO APPROVE the recommendations of the expert committee regarding two cut off dates fixed for P.G. in Allied Health Sciences as detailed below:

For the candidates admitted in the academic year 2011-12 alone, who were admitted upto 30th June 2011 the examination will be conducted from 15th May 2012, and for candidates admitted upto 31st October 2011 the Examination will be conducted from 15th November 2012.

Dr. Dhayakani Selvakumar requested the board to reconsider to start the MSc (Bio-Chemistry) MSc (Microbiology) which was dispensed by the university.
