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The 43rd meeting of the Standing Academic Board was held on 19.12.2011 and it  
was resolved as follows:

- I. TO INFORM THE COMMENCEMENT OF EXAMINATION DATES FOR THE TWO  
CUT OFF DATES FIXED FOR PG IN ALLIED HEALTH SCIENCES FOR THE  
ACADEMIC YEAR 2011-12 AND IN FUTURE.

Resolved to approve the recommendations of the expert committee regarding two cut off  
dates fixed for P.G. Courses under Allied Health Sciences as detailed below from the Academic  
year 2012-2013 onwards:

Course	Course commences	Cut off date	Examination
PG Allied Health Science for regular batch	May 2 <sup>nd</sup>	May 31 <sup>st</sup>	April 15 <sup>th</sup>
PG Allied Health Science for supplementary batch	October 1 <sup>st</sup>	October 31 <sup>st</sup>	October 15 <sup>th</sup>

“ For the candidates admitted in the academic year 2011-12 alone, who were admitted upto  
30th June 2011 the Examination Will be conducted from 15th May 2012, and for candidates  
admitted upto 31st October 2011 the Examination will be conducted from 15th November 2012.”

II Further the recommendations of the Board of Studies in Physiotherapy and Occupational Therapy held on 8.12.2011 have resolved as follows:

1. The board has resolved as follows with regard to modification in the carry over of failed subjects in the regulation of the BPT course.

The first year and second year subject should be passed before entering into the final year.

The candidates can carry over only two subjects of III year to the final year and write along with final year examination. If the candidate fails in more than two subjects of the III year subject, it is a break. This will come into force from August 2012 Examination and the same will be published in the University Web Site.

The board has resolved not to approve the change of subject name of Community Medicine as Community Physiotherapy.

2. The board has resolved and accepted the uniform pattern of evaluating P G Dissertation of MPT & MOT as follows :

Dissertation	- 200 marks	Minimum pass mark	100
Presentation	- 50 marks	Minimum pass mark	25
Orals on dissertation	- 50 marks	Minimum pass mark	25

3. Any other item:

The board has resolved to appoint Physiotherapist with 10 years of teaching experience after UG or 5 years of teaching experience after PG as question setter and evaluator for Basic and Applied Physics for Physiotherapy. The above decision was approved in Resolution No. 44, of the 209th meeting of the Governing Council held on 22.12.2012.

4. The above decisions are communicated for information and to take necessary action.

The Principals are also requested to circulate the above matters among the Professors/Head of the Department /Student of their college and also to display it in the College Notice Board and the Department Notice Board for information of the student.
