The Board of Studies recommends the following AHS(UG) degree Courses.

TO DISCUSS AND APPROVE THE RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE EXPERT COMMITTEE MEETING FOR BACHELOR OF PROSTHETICS & ORTHOTICS UNDER ALLIED HEALTH SCIENCE.

The Board resolved to approve the recommendations of the Expert Committee. The University should insist the institution who are conducting the course should get prior approval from the Rehabilitation Council of India and affiliation from the Tamilnadu Dr. M.G.R. Medical University.

The Board further resolved that the institution must have sufficient Faculty, Beds per student strength and all other facilities including Prosthetic and Orthotic units in accordance with the Rehabilitation Council of India guidelines.

Hence in the Expert Committee suggestions list the point No. 12 saying that the institution must have a 50 bedded hospital on their own or tie up with any reputed hospital – the above mentioned line should be included

The Board resolved to start B.Sc.,(Respiratory Therapy) Under Allied Health Sciences and to constitute expert committee to frame the syllabus and Regulations.

TO CONSIDER THE MODIFICATIONS IN THE SYLLABUS FOR B.Sc.,(PHYSICIAN ASSISTANT), B.Sc.,(CARDIO PULMONARY AND PERFUSION TECHNOLOGY), B.Sc., (DIALYSIS TECHNOLOGY), B.Sc.,(OPERATION THEATRE AND ANESTHESIA TECHNOLOGY) AND B.Sc.,(MEDICAL SOCIOLOGY).

The Board resolved to constitute the expert committees with the experts from the concerned speciality for B.Sc. (Physician Assistant), B.Sc. (Cardio Pulmonary and Perfusion Technology), B.Sc. (Dialysis Technology), B.Sc. (Operation Theatre and Anesthesia Technology and B.Sc. (Medical Sociology) to revise the Syllabus of above courses. In these committees at least one adhoc / invitee member who already have teaching experience or have studied & qualified in the above courses to be included. These revised syllabi will be implemented from 2014-2015 admission onwards.

TO CONSIDER AND DECIDE TO GIVE EFFECT TO THE REVISED SYLLABUS AND SCHEME OF EXAMINATION OF ALLIED HEALTH UG / DIPLOMA COURSES UNIFORMLY WITH EFFECT FROM THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2013-2014 ONWARDS INSTEAD OF FROM THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2012-2013.

The Board resolved to constitute the expert committee to revise the Syllabus for the following courses with experts from the concerned specialities and the same will be implemented from 2014-2015 admission onwards.

1. B.Sc. Accident and Emergency Care Technology
2. B.Sc. Cardiac Technology
3. B.Sc. Cardio Pulmonary Perfusion Care Technology
4. B.Sc. Critical Care Technology
5. B.Sc. Dialysis Technology
6. B.Sc. Medical Sociology
7. B.Sc. Operation Theatre & Anesthesia Technology
8. B.Sc. Physician Assistant
9. B.Sc. Radiology Imaging Technology
10. B.Sc. Radiotherapy Technology

Any other items:

1. Proposal received from the Director & Professor, Barnard Institute of radiology and Oncology, Madras Medical College, Chennai with regard to the revising and upgrading of the syllabus for B.Sc. in Radio Diagnosis Technology and Radio Therapy Technology.

The Board resolved to revise the syllabus of the above course as per the norms of the Atomic Energy Regulatory Board (AERB) by constituting the expert committee.

2. Proposal received from Sundaram Medical Foundation for revising the Syllabus, Text Books and Question Paper Pattern in B.Sc. Accident and Emergency Care Technology.

The Board resolved to constitute the expert committee to revise the Syllabus for B.Sc.,(Accident and Emergency Care Technology) with experts from the concerned specialities and the same will be implemented from 2014-2015 admission onwards.

3. Continuance of Provisional Affiliation for B.Sc. Medical Record Science (three years course) to be granted to Christian Medical College, Vellore afresh as they are under the affiliation of two years granted earlier by this University for B.M.R.Sc. course.

The Board has recommended that the affiliation order issued to Christian Medical College, Vellore for B.M.R.Sc. two years course earlier by this University will be modified and continuance of provisional affiliation be issued to the above institution for B.Sc. in Medical Record Science of three years course, as the duration of the course changes from two years to three years and the nomenclature of the course also changed retrospectively from 2011-2012 onwards.

The Board suggested to frame the II Year Syllabus of D.M.R.Sc. immediately to be made effective from August 2013 examination onwards by constituting the expert committee accordingly.

STREAMLINING OF PARA MEDICAL DIPLOMA/DEGREE COURSES IN ALLIED HEALTH SCIENCES.

Resolved that uniformly for all the courses under Allied health Sciences, the eligibility criteria be fixed as +2 from the academic year 2013-14 onwards. Accordingly, the syllabus for all the courses under Allied Health Sciences be modified by constituting Committee with field experts.
