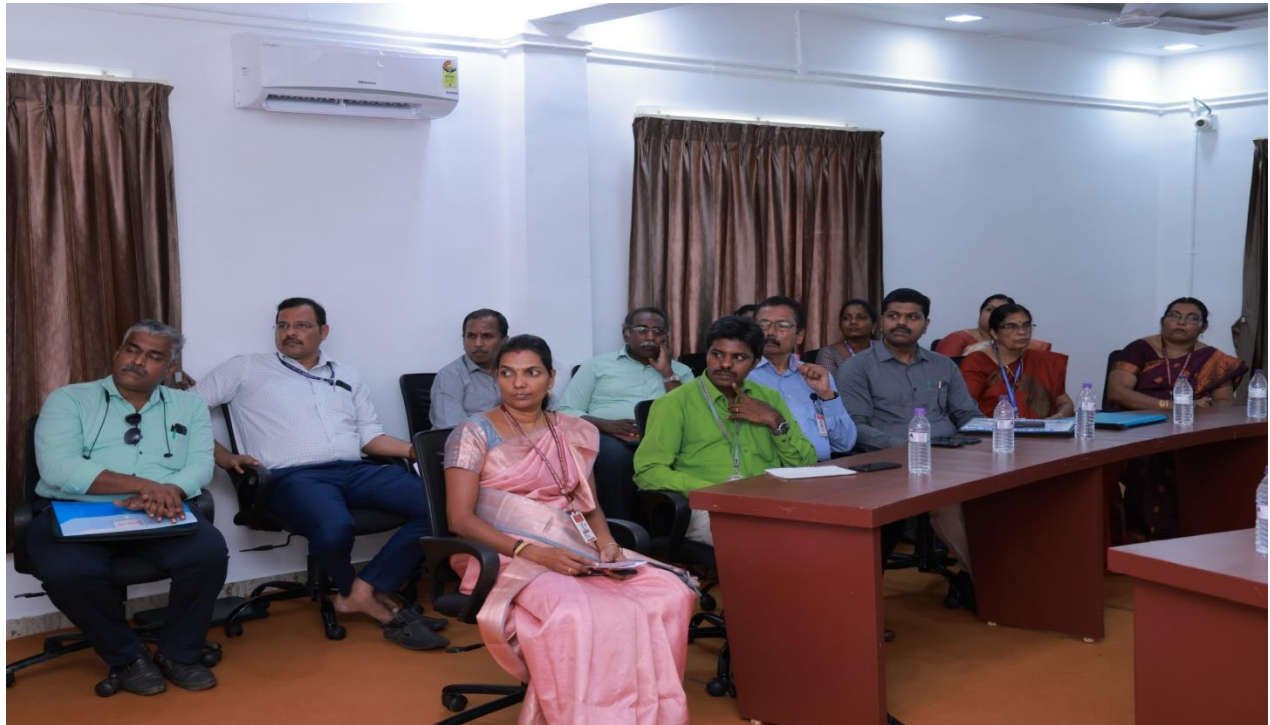




The Vice-chancellor interacted with the principals of AYUSH Institutions about various aspects of their facilities and research related works in their institution and also discussed the proforma given by this University.
